

ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS

**RE: Fundraising Activities
Students**

1. Student fund raising events shall be kept to a minimum. No fund raising activity of any type shall take place without the prior approval of the building principal.
2. Those engaged in fund raising activities should make clear the school organization for which the funds are being raised.
3. Fund raising projects shall be limited to items and activities not generally funded through the school district budget.
4. Fund raising activities should not interfere with the regular operation of the school.
5. The principal shall approve the product for sale and shall be concerned with both the cost and the quality of the product.
6. No student shall be required to sell anything as a condition for participation in any school sponsored activity. Participation in fund raising activities shall be voluntary.
7. Students engaged in fund raising activities shall be permitted to sell raffle tickets on merchandise.
8. Any fund raising activities must comply with all applicable state and federal laws and regulations, including those provisions relating to the sale of healthy foods and beverages on school grounds or at school-sponsored events.
